Question 26 - August 27, 2002 - Nikki from Knoxville, TN asked, “Why could not see that Raychel was going to die, or did you?”

Response 26: It is very difficult for me to understand exactly why I failed Raychel (and I do feel that I somehow failed Raychel in that regard). However, I believe that the reason I was unable to receive a precognitive message regarding her being in danger is because I had become too close to her.
